RAGGING FREE CAMPUS

Duration : 5 ½ years and 1 year of Internship

Eligibility : – Passed 10+2 (Class XII) or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English. – Minimum aggregate: ~50% in PCB for general category relaxations apply for reserved categories). – Entrance requirement: NEET (UG) counselling as applicable—follow WBUAFS counselling schedules for seat allotment.

Age :- Not less than 17 years as on 31st December of that year of admission. There shall be a relaxation of the upper age limit by maximum 5 (five) years for SC/ST/OBC (CATEGORY-A) & OBC (CATEGORY-B) candidates.

How to apply : – Fill the college admission form (online/offline) and upload 10+2 marksheet, photo ID and entrance scorecard (NEET) where required. – Application deadlines and seat intake will follow the affiliating university and VCI/State counselling calendar.

COURSE CURRICULUM

The college follows a structured curriculum based on national MSVE (Minimum Standards of Veterinary Education) guidelines: core subjects include Veterinary Anatomy, Physiology & Biochemistry, Livestock Production Management, Microbiology, Veterinary Pathology, Animal Genetics & Breeding, Animal Nutrition, Pharmacology & Toxicology, Veterinary Public Health & Epidemiology, Parasitology, Livestock Product Technology, Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Extension Education, Veterinary Medicine, Veterinary Surgery & Radiology, Veterinary Gynaecology & Obstetrics, Veterinary Clinical Complex and Livestock Farm Complex.
