ORDER

Whereas the JIS College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Mogra located in the Hooghly District has, vide their letter no. JISCOVAS/DAHD/GOI/2025-26/016 dated 10.01.2026 has informed that the centralised counselling under the West Bengal University of Animal and Fishery Sciences has ended on 10 January 2026, and that there are still some candidates seeking admission in the vacant seats of B. V. Sc. & A.H. Degree Course, and accordingly the said College has approached this Department for permitting decentralised counselling for filling up their vacant seats,

Whereas the West Bengal University of Animal and Fishery Sciences vide their letter no. WBUAFS/Estb/JIS-CVAS/80 dated 15/01/2026 has requested this Department to issue a Notification permitting decentralised counselling along the lines of the Higher Education Department,

Whereas it is seen that the Higher Education Department, the nodal Department for higher and technical education in the State of West Bengal, permits such decentralised counselling each year, after the closure of the centralised counselling for engineering and other professional courses under its ambit, and the latest such Order has been issued vide their number 326-Edn(T)/10 M-86/ 2015 dated 15 September 2025,

Whereas the broad approach of the State Government with regard to professional courses has been to ensure the filling up of all available seats subject to the fulfilment of the admission eligibility criteria and conditions specified by the relevant regulatory authorities,

Now, therefore, the State Government hereby decides that in order to fill up the vacant seats, the admission of students through decentralised counselling is permitted against the vacant seats of B. V. Sc. & AH Degree Course in the said professional College, to be completed not later than 31 January 2026, subject to merit and all other admission criteria specified by the relevant regulatory authorities.

The said institution shall declare the list of vacant seats in their Notice Board and their website inviting clear Notice seeking application from the eligible and willing candidates for admission. It shall publish the list of applicants eligible shortlisted for admission as against the declared vacant seats. Admission shall be made in order of merit and in a transparent manner. It shall publish the list of finally-admitted students along with all the relevant details and submit the same to the West Bengal University of Animal and Fishery Sciences.

This entire arrangement will be subject to the rules and regulations, directions and guidelines of the relevant regulatory authorities.

This issues with the approval of the competent authority of the Department.
